This scholarship was endowed by the family of Ann Pittman Andrews, who taught in the English Department at Mississippi State University for 26 years.

The Andrews Scholarship

This scholarship provides \$1000.00 toward a student's tuition (\$500.00 per semester).

When to apply:

Applications are due March 1 for scholarships awarded for the following academic year (August-May).

Who may apply:

Applicants must be full-time MSU students and English majors with a minimum G.P.A. of 3.0.

How to apply:

To apply for the Dr. Cecil Hunter and Ann Pittman Andrews Memorial Endowed Scholarship, please log into Banner and, under the Financial Aid and Scholarships column, click "Submit/Revise General Scholarship Application." Fill out the general application, and then apply for the Andrews Scholarship.

In addition to information required from all scholarship applicants, the system will ask you for two more things that are necessary to be considered for the Andrews Scholarship:

- 1. Two letters of recommendation. Ask two instructors whether they are willing to recommend you—recommendations from any instructors are welcome, but do consider asking instructors from English courses. Once you have their permission, put their names and email addresses in your application, and the system will send your instructors emails inviting them to submit their letters on-line. *The same instructors may recommend you for multiple scholarships*
- 2. An essay of approximately 500 words that demonstrates your engagement with your major by describing in detail your work in one or more of your English courses. Your essay may address multiple elements of your work (such as reading, analysis, writing, research), or it may focus on whichever element you have found most stimulating and rewarding.

(The same essay may also be used in your application for the English Department's Dabbs, Shurlds, and Skelton Scholarships.)
