As you plan, you need to know the following details that sometimes cause trouble for students who are unaware of them:

- 1. You need a total of 124 hours for the BA in English.
- 2. You need a total of 32 hours of upper-division credit (that is, courses at the 3000 or 4000 level) in the college of Arts and Sciences in order to graduate. 24 of those hours are required (your upper-division English courses and HI 3743), but remember the other 8 hours as you choose the rest of your courses.
- 3. You need at least a C in all of your English courses above the 2000 level, and you need a G.P.A. of 2.5 in your English courses overall.
- 4. You must take EN 3414, Advanced Composition, before or simultaneously with your first 4000-level English course.
